Dear Parade Participant:

Welcome to the 2010 Grape Festival Feature Parade held on Sunday, September 5, 2010. The parade is scheduled to start at 2:00 p.m. near the east edge of Nauvoo on Highway 96, proceed west through the Mulholland business district, and then south toward the State Park. We will have a registration desk set up at the ****NAUVOO FIRE STATION**** (on the north side of the highway one block east of the large brick motel) and we ask that you check in there when you arrive. For those of you in competitive categories, we will provide you with a number to be displayed on the right front of your entry. Our registration desk will be open at 10:30 a.m. (cell phone (309) 221-3878) and we would like all entrants checked in by 12:30 p.m. (bands by 1:15 p.m.). The judges will review the competitive entries between 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. and will make final evaluations as you pass them later along the parade route.

The parade will end south of the State Park Shelter House traveling east on Parley Street. Entries needing to exit east from Nauvoo or return to vehicles at the beginning of the parade will continue east on Parley through the park and through the main parking lot east of the carnival. Band buses and parade entries desiring to stay and enjoy the activities on the Midway, see the Mounted Cowboys Shooting Demonstration, Car Show, Buckskinners, Arts & Crafts, Flea Market, Entertainment Tent, etc. may park on the service road to the park headquarters' building east of the carnival.

Cash award winner's checks will be mailed and should be received by October 6, 2010. Trophy winners will be notified by September 15th and may pick up their trophies at the winery at 2010 East Parley Street.
